1. JAZZ SUMMIT (non-competitive)

- Designed for all jazz groups
- 30-minute performance slot with on-stage clinic
- Trophies awarded to all groups rated "Outstanding" by adjudicators

2. JAZZ HERITAGE (competitive)

- Designed for advanced jazz bands
- Groups perform three selections from approved list of songs recorded by Count Basie
- Judging based on list of criteria including stylistic accuracy and authenticity
- Top scoring group awarded a trophy and invitation to perform on evening concert

3. JAZZ TYRO (educational)

- Designed for groups with little experience or unconventional instrumentation
- Clinicians comments will be inspirational and focused on building groups' confidence
